ALL ABOUT AUTISM: Finding some answers in order to welcome and engage special children and youth Autism appears to be on the rise and many questions are also quickly rising regarding its causes, characteristics, and appropriate interventions.

Despite all the questions, one thing is for certain: Children and youth with autism (and their parents) need to experience the welcoming love of Jesus through the church.
